

60-11F - EFFECTIVE REVISIONS OF SPECIFICATIONS:

The Specification Effectivity Index (SEI) presents the effective revisions of specifications; these are instructions for which revision(s) is/are allowable for use:

A. Supplier shall comply with the specification revision invoked in the Purchase Order, however, at the Supplier's discretion, an alternate revision designated within the SEI may be used, without further approval of Buyer, provided such is identified as allowable (interchangeable) by the "Interchangeability Code" within the SEI.

B. If there is need to utilize a revision of a specification that is not identified to be allowable by the SEI, Supplier should submit a Vendor Information Request (VIR) to Buyer requesting authorization to use the alternate revision.

C. When a specification revision is not cited in the Purchase Order, starting at the revision in effect at time of Purchase Order issuance, Supplier may use any revision identified to be allowable per the SEI.

D. When a specification revision is not cited in the Purchase Order or the SEI, any issued revision may be used. This includes using any superseding documents the publishing body of the specification directs one to use. If the superseding document is on the SEI the supplier must comply with the requirements for effective specification revisions of specifications listed on the SEI.

Note: When the SEI is referred to above, the Supplier may use any one (1) dated version of the SEI for a Purchase Order Line Item, as long as it is dated no earlier than six (6) months before the date of the applicable Purchase Order Line Item. In instances where 60-11D or 60-11E was originally invoked for the Purchase Order Line Item, the supplier may use both the 60-11F SEI Report and the previously invoked (60-11D or 60-11E) SEI Report for determining material specification effectivity. In this case, the supplier is limited to using one (1) dated version of each SEI report that is dated no earlier than six (6) months before the date of the applicable Purchase Order. In the case of a conflict between the 60-11F

SEI and the legacy version for the same material specification revision/transition, the 60-11F SEI takes precedence.
