The wire furnished for each item must be in one continuous length as specified, unless otherwise approved by modification to this purchase order.

The spool/spools of wire must be marked with the purchase order and item number, with stamped rustproof metal or waterproof paper tags having letters and figures 3/8" high or larger and securely fastened on each face of the spool, so that the spool numbers may be determined when stored close together. The spool/spools must also contain the following information for identification purposes plainly stenciled with painted letters and figures on each face of the spool:

- Quantity of wire on spool (as designated)
- Type and size of wire (as designated)
- Purchase order number and item number
- Newport News Part Number (NNPN)

The coil/coils must be substantially tagged and the tag legibly marked with its purchase order and item number as given above. The tag must also bear the following information for identification purposes:

- Quantity of wire in coil (as designated)
- Type and size of wire (as designated)
- Purchase order number and item number
- Newport News Part Number (NNPN)
