A Certification of Compliance, Appendix, "Crane Certification" (see copy attached) must be completed in its entirety and displayed on all cranes at all times while the cranes are on Newport News Shipbuilding (NNS) property.

This certification must be signed by a company officer of the contractor whose company provides cranes for any lifting and handling work at (NNS). By his signature, the contractor certifies that the crane and crane operators provided by his company for work at NNS complies with the following minimum requirements:

- Crane meets all applicable OSHA requirements;
- Equipment operators and crews meet all regulatory agency requirements;
- All equipment and personnel certifications will remain valid while operating at NNS;
- All cranes shall be equipped with an anti-two-blocking device, which when activated, disables all crane functions whose movement can cause two-blocking;
- No safety device will be by-passed during lifting and handling operations at NNS;
- Any lifting and handling related accident or incident involving contractor cranes or operators will be reported in accordance with NNS Procedure Y-1046.
