Materials which contain the following components shall not be shipped without prior written approval by our purchasing department: arsenic, mercury, benzene, 2-nitropropane, lead, **leaded compounds**, chromate **material**, or organo-metallic material.

All paint coating products required by this purchase order shall meet all applicable OSHA requirements, including providing a complete and accurate **GHS compliant [Text deleted]** Safety Data Sheet[**Text deleted**].

In addition, all paint coatings supplied[**Text deleted**] by this purchase order containing greater than or equal to 0.1% (by weight) lead **and lead compounds** shall have the lead content specified on the [**Text deleted**] Safety Data Sheet.

Upon request, the vendor shall supply to Newport News Shipbuilding the results of the chemical analysis of a typical sample of the dry paint film to show maximum leachable concentrations [**Text deleted**] of contaminants or characteristics of E.P. Toxicity. The analysis shall have been performed in accordance with Hazardous Wastes Regulation as stated in 40CFR261 for the listed heavy metals.
