STR-701 HAZMAT MINIMIZATION

#### H1701 HAZARDOUS MATERIAL MINIMIZATION PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

If Supplementary Technical Requirement STR-701 "Hazardous Material Minimization in Electronic/Electrical and Commercial Components and Maintenance Equipment" is not included in Appendix B of this purchase order, then this coded note H1701 does not apply to this purchase order.

If STR-701 is included in Appendix B of this purchase order, then the supplier shall comply with this STR. This STR specifies hazardous material minimization, identification, and documentation requirements for the items to be delivered on this purchase order.

The supplier shall complete a "Supplier Hazmat Review Form" (NN9168) or an equivalent report or letter if the supplier determines that hazardous materials as defined in paragraph 2.3 of STR-701 are present in the item to be delivered on this purchase order.

The supplier shall send the completed form, report, or letter to the CVN 21 ESOH GROUP prior to shipment of the material at:

In addition to the reporting requirement above, if the item contains mercury, mercury compounds, and/or polychlorinated biphenyls (PCB) as an ingredient, then use of these hazardous materials must be justified by the supplier and approved by Newport News Shipbuilding prior to shipment using the Vendor Information Request (VIR) process described in Appendix A of this purchase order.

The supplier acknowledges by receipt of this order that if no completed "Supplier Hazmat Review Form" (NN9168) or equivalent report or letter is provided to the recipient listed above, then the items supplied by this order do not contain hazardous material as defined by STR-701. All suppliers, including those that do not provide a completed Form NN9168, may be audited by Newport News Shipbuilding to verify compliance with STR-701.

The supplier shall send the "Supplier Hazmat Review Form" or equivalent only once to represent multiple orders of the same Newport News material number provided there are no changes to the part. If there is a change in the type, quantity, or application of hazmat in the item, then the supplier shall send an updated hazmat review form or equivalent, and a letter that describes how to physically distinguish between the old and new parts (serial numbers, model numbers, physical appearance, etc.).

Refer to Appendix A of this purchase order for additional mercury exclusion requirements.
