Title: **HAZARDOUS MATERIAL RESTRICTION**

If Appendix B of this purchase order does not include a section titled "Hazardous Material Minimization", the supplier does not have to comply with this coded note.

If Appendix B of this purchase order does include a section titled "Hazardous Material Minimization", the supplier shall comply with the following restriction:

The material/equipment required by this purchase order item shall not contain the following hazardous materials:

Asbestos, Barium, Barium Compounds, Boron Trifluoride, Cadmium, Cadmium Compounds, Chromium, Chromium Compounds, Lead, Lead Compounds, Mercury, Mercury Compounds, Class I Ozone Depleting Substances (as defined in Code of Federal Regulations 40CFR82, Subpart A, Appendix A), Polychlorinated Biphenyl Compounds (PCB), Selenium, Selenium Compounds, Silver, and Silver Compounds. These are defined as hazardous material according to the NAVSEA Hazardous Material Minimization Procedure.

The following are excluded from the requirements of this coded note: (1) a hazardous material that is an impurity, I.E., a trace amount that is not an ingredient and does not contribute to the function or usefulness of the item; (2) a hazardous material that is an ingredient in a metal alloy, except for Lead in a concentration greater than 1 percent in Brass or Bronze.
