If Appendix B of this purchase order **[Text deleted]** includes a section titled "Hazardous Material Minimization", the supplier shall comply with the following restriction:

The material/equipment required by this purchase order item, **including any coatings applied to the material / equipment**, shall not contain the following hazardous materials:

Asbestos; Barium **[Text deleted] Metal and** Compounds; Boron Trifluoride; **Brass with >1% Lead; Bronze with >1% Lead**; Cadmium **[Text deleted] Metal and** Compounds, Chromium **[Text deleted] Metal and** Compounds; Lead **[Text deleted] Metal and** Compounds; Mercury **[Text deleted] Metal and** Compounds; Class I Ozone Depleting Substances (as defined in Code of Federal Regulations 40CFR82, Subpart A, Appendix A); Polychlorinated Biphenyl Compounds (PCB); Selenium **[Text deleted] Metal and** Compounds; Silver **[Text deleted] Metal and** Compounds. **[Text deleted]**

The following are excluded from the requirements of this coded note: (1) a hazardous material that is an impurity, i.e., a trace amount that is not an ingredient and does not contribute to the function or usefulness of the **[Text deleted] material / equipment**; (2) a hazardous material that is an ingredient in a metal alloy, except for Lead in a concentration greater than 1 percent in Brass or Bronze.

[Text deleted] If a change in the type, quantity, or application of hazmat in the material/equipment is necessary, the change must be approved by Newport News Shipbuilding prior to shipment using the Vendor Information Request (VIR) process

described in Appendix A - NNS Supplement of this purchase order. The VIR shall include a Supplier Hazmat Review form (NN 9168), a description of the change, and how to physically distinguish between the old and new material/equipment (serial numbers, model numbers, physical appearance, etc.).

If Appendix B of this purchase order does not include a section titled “Hazardous Material Minimization”, the supplier does not have to comply with this coded note.
