PACKING AND SHIPPING REQTS FOR POLY SHEETS

PACKING AND SHIPPING REQT FOR POLY SHEETS

PACKING AND SHIPMENT SHALL BE SUCH THAT MATERIAL IS NOT DAMAGED AND THAT TAGS ON EACH ITEM SHALL REMAIN INTACT, IN PLACE ARE LEGIBLE FOR SHORT TIME STORAGE AND HANDLING AFTER RECEIPT. PACKING SHALL ENSURE MAINTENANCE OF THE DEGREE OF CLEANLINESS REQUIRED FOR THE COMPONENT OR PART UNTIL DELIVERED AND ACCEPTED AT THE SHIPPING DESTINATION.

SHEETS SHALL BE PACKED IN CONTAINERS IN A MANNER TO ENSURE SAFE DELIVERY AND ACCEPTANCE AT DESTINATION. CONTAINERS SHALL COMPLY WITH THE UNIFORM FREIGHT CLASSIFICATION REGULATION AS A MINIMUM. SKIDS OF MATERIAL SHOULD BE STACKED ON EQUALLY SPACED STORAGE SUPPORTS WHICH ARE LARGE ENOUGH TO SUPPORT THE ENTIRE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE SKID IN A MANNER THAT WILL PRECLUDE SAGGING AND SUBSEQUENT DISTORTION. THE MAXIMUM HEIGHT FOR STACKING/LOADING OF PURCHASE ORDER MATERIAL ON A SKID/PALLET SHALL NOT EXCEED 36 INCHES, INCLUDING THE HEIGHT OF THE SKID/PALLET. THE MAXIMUM COMBINED WEIGHT OF THE MATERIAL AND THE SKID/PALLET SHALL NOT EXCEED 2,500 POUNDS.

EACH CONTAINER SHALL BE MARKED WITH THE FOLLOWING:

- MANUFACTURER'S NAME OR SYMBOL
- SPECIFICATION AND TYPE
- LOT IDENTIFICATION
- PURCHASE ORDER AND ITEM NUMBER

MATERIAL IS FOR DOMESTIC SHIPMENT AND IMMEDIATE USE.

NOTE: THE USE OF YELLOW WRAPPING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
