Title: **PACKING AND SHIPPING REQUIREMENTS FOR LEAD WOOL ROPE**

Packing and shipment shall be such that material is not damaged and that tags on each item shall remain intact, in place and legible for short time storage and handling after receipt. Packing shall ensure maintenance of the degree of cleanliness required for the component or part until delivered and accepted at the shipping destination.

The lead wool shall be packed in 50 pound quantities, in sealed impermeable, transparent plastic envelope, with silica-gel inside of each plastic container. The plastic bag shall be shipped inside a reinforced double paper sack, Kraft or equal. Each exterior container shall be marked with the following:

- Manufacturer's Trade Name or Brand
- Specification Number and Grade
- Purchase Order and Item Number
- Melt Code Number or Packaging Date
- The letters "TL"
- Each shipping container must be clearly marked with the applicable shipping release number(s)

Each shipment must include a packing list.

Note: The use of yellow wrapping is strictly prohibited.
