**** SPECIAL NOTE ****

Paint shall not be applied on corrosion resistant piping and components. **Examples of corrosion resisting materials are as follows:**

- Corrosion Resistant Steels
- Nickel-Copper Alloys
- Copper-Nickel Alloys
- Nickel-Chromium-Iron Alloys
- Brass, Bronze, Gun Metals
- Copper
- **Cobalt Based Alloys**
- **Titanium**

Any paint splatters shall be removed from these surfaces immediately. Paint removal shall be accomplished only by the use of stainless steel wire brushes, stainless steel **wire wheels** or acetone **soaked cloths** (unused or redistilled).
