Title: **LABEL PLATES IAW MIL-P-15024**

Identification and information label plates shall be in accordance with MIL-P-15024 Rev C dated 29 February 1968 except as follows:

1. The minimum depth of marking for types a, b and c identification and information plates shall be:
  - (a) 0.007 inch for corrosion resisting steel, Types A, B, or C plates.
  - (b) 0.015 inch for nickel-copper or brass Type A plates.
  - (c) 0.030 inch for nickel-copper or brass Type B or C plates.
2. The minimum depths specified in paragraph 3.7.3.3 of MIL-P-15024 shall apply for additional information stamped on type D plates.
3. Aluminum shall not be used for identification or information plates.
4. All metallic identification or information plates shall contain the wording: "Do Not Polish".
5. Adhesive tape identification, information label plates or adhesive installation method for securing metallic labels is prohibited.
6. For nickel-copper or brass Type "B" or "C" plated, the minimum plate thickness shall be 0.045 inches.
