

MARKING REQUIREMENTS

WHERE MIL-STD-792 IS REFERENCED IT SHALL BE REVISION F DATED 19 MAY 2006.

THE FOLLOWING MATERIAL IDENTIFICATION AND CONTROL REQUIREMENTS MUST BE IMPLEMENTED IN THE VENDOR'S INSPECTION SYSTEM.

THE MARKING AND OTHER MATERIAL CONTROL REQUIREMENTS SPECIFIED HEREIN ARE THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS AND ANY ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED BY THE PROCUREMENT SPECIFICATION MUST BE MET.

MATERIAL IDENTIFICATION AND OTHER MARKINGS MUST BE APPLIED BY THE MARKING METHODS PRESCRIBED IN THE APPLICABLE PROCUREMENT OR MANUFACTURING SPECIFICATION, EXCEPT THAT THE MARKINGS REQUIRED TO BE PERMANENT BY THE PURCHASE ORDER MUST ALWAYS BE APPLIED BY A PERMANENT MARKING METHOD OF MIL-STD-792. WHERE THE PROCUREMENT OR MANUFACTURING SPECIFICATION DOES NOT PRESCRIBE SPECIFIC MARKING METHODS, MARKING SHALL BE APPLIED BY THE METHODS (AND WITHIN THE RESTRICTIONS) OF MIL-STD-792. REGARDLESS OF THE SPECIFICATION USED FOR MARKING METHODS, THE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY:

- TYPE V MARKINGS ARE PERMITTED ON FASTENERS REGARDLESS OF THE MATERIAL.
- PAINT SHALL NOT BE APPLIED ON CORROSION RESISTANT PIPING AND COMPONENTS (I.E., STAINLESS STEEL, NICU, CUNI, NICRFE, BRASS, BRONZE, COPPER)

IF INFORMATION IS REQUIRED TO BE TEMPORARILY MARKED BY THIS PURCHASE ORDER AND IS REQUIRED TO BE PERMANENTLY MARKED BY THE INVOKED SPECIFICATION, A PERMANENT MARKING METHOD MUST BE USED.

TEMPORARY MARKING MAY BE APPLIED TO THE CONTAINER OR BUNDLE WHERE THE INFORMATION IS COMMON TO ALL THE MATERIAL IN THE CONTAINER OR BUNDLE. IN SUCH CASES WHERE AN ITEM IS REMOVED FROM THE CONTAINER OR BUNDLE, THE REMOVED ITEM SHALL BE MARKED WITH THE THE REQUIRED INFORMATION.
