PROCEDURE SUBMITTAL:

Prior to performing Fluidborne, Structureborne and Airborne Noise Tests, the proposed fluidborne, structureborne and airborne noise test procedures shall be submitted for approval. These procedures shall be submitted for approval at least six weeks prior to testing.

The request for approval shall include:  
Current purchase order/item number(s),  
NN Material Number(s),  
This coded note number,  
The procedure number/revision,

In the event the scheduled date for submittal cannot be met, the supplier shall provide a complete list of all documents and revisions to be used in advance of submittal. Full compliance to this submittal requirement is expected.

PRIOR APPROVED PROCEDURE(S):

If prior approval has been obtained from NNS but the procedure number and revision **is not listed** on this purchase order, re-submittal of the procedure is not required. A request for extension of the previous approval shall be submitted and shall include the information detailed above.

NO SUBMITTAL REQUIRED:

If prior approval has been obtained from NNS and the procedure and revision **is listed** on this purchase order, no additional submittal is required to satisfy this requirement. In this instance the supplier is authorized to perform work.

The above requirements do not relieve the seller of his responsibility to comply with the specification requirements of the purchase order.
