Security Requirements

(1) Manufacturing Process

The alarm switchboards and connection boxes shall be unclassified during the manufacturing process provided that the schematic wiring diagram is not included with, or attached to the equipment.

Keys and schematic wiring diagrams, when designated for a security alarm system shall be classified secret.

(2) Shipping

The alarm switchboards and/or connection boxes shall be shipped unclassified. Equipment (switchboards and/or connection boxes) shall be locked when shipped. Keys and schematic wiring diagram shall be shipped separately and classified secret.

A. Uncrating instructions and shipping invoice for security alarm equipment shall include the following statement:

"Special Handling Required-Refer to Newport News Procedure M-48/148 Prior to Uncrating or Stowage."

B. Shipping cartons or boxes shall be clearly marked:

"Special Handling Required"
