Protection During Shipment

Failure to provide adequate protection for equipment on this order during shipment may result in additional expense and lost time for both the seller and buyer, and thus become a serious deterrent to the submarine construction program.

Extreme care must be exercised in packing, crating and shipping any item tested in accordance with Appendix H.

The following minimum requirements must be met:

- A) Prior to packaging, equipment will be tagged and identified as "sensitive, low noise level equipment, handle with care". Each crate or container will include unpacking instructions.
- B) Equipment must be packaged, braced and crated for domestic shipment in a manner that will protect built-in noise reduction features from rough handling during shipment.
- C) The following identification will be stenciled on two sides and both ends of the shipping crate:

"Sensitive, Low Noise Level Equipment - Handle with Extreme Care."

(Letters are to be two inches high, if space permits).

Arrows will be stenciled on the crate to indicate "This Side Up".

- D) Seller will alert the carrier of the necessity to handle the shipment with extreme care.
- E) Heavy propulsion components are to be shipped in open-top trailers (protected from the weather) to permit direct overhead lifting operations when unloading

(to avoid dragging or pushing to an access door).
