All relief valves, both individual and those in component assemblies, must be provided with a positive means to prevent unauthorized manipulation of the adjusting mechanism once the valve has been finally set by the manufacturer or purchaser. A means for allowing the installation of a lockwire is preferred unless configuration precludes this type of seal.

Receipt of valves that are required to be provided by the supplier with a "Relief Valve Setting Certificate" will not be accepted by the purchaser without the lockwire installed.

Valves that are not required to be provided with a "Relief Valve Setting Certificate" are acceptable with or without lockwire installed.
